Mr. Glover s uncle being in that high situation, it was originally intended that he should be brought up to the law; but the Lord Chancellor dying when his nephew was very young, the plan was altered, and he was brought up to his father s profession. Mr. Glover, by a lady he married (Miss Nunn) of the county of Essex, and with whom he received a considerable fortune, had three children; a daughter, who died young; Captain Glover, who died in the service of his country off the island of Jamaica, commanding his Majesty s ship Janus; and Richard, his surviving son, who served in the last parliament fort the borough of Penryn, in Cornwall.
