

Peeke, pastor of the Congregational Church, led in the devotional exercises, and greeted the teachers as co-workers. Supt. I. M. Clemens, of Ashtabula, President of the Section, was then introduced and read his inaugural address. , Because of the temporary absence of the Treasurer, Principal M. S. Campbell, of Cleveland, Messrs. C. L. Loos, of Dayton, and E. F. Moulton, of Warren, were appointed to take charge of the finances of the Association until the arrival of the Treasurer. Hon. E. T. Tappan, State Commissioner of Common Schools, introduced the subject of Township Supervision, and was followed by Hon. N. H. Albaugh, of Tadmor. The discussion was further participated in by Messrs. R. H. Holbrook, of Lebanon, Arthur Powell, of Wadsworth, N. H. Albaugh, A. A. Bartow, of Sandusky, E. H. Webb, of North Fairfield, and U. T. Curran, of Sandusky. After a piano solo by Miss Lehrer, the Association adjourned until 2 oclock. AFTERNOON SESSION. The session was opened with music by Miss Annie Knight. Supts. Alston...
