This fundamental understanding is the reason for the necessity of corporate governance rules. As a pro-tection of shareholder interests, the interests of the owners of the company, the regulator tries to set standards which create investor confidence and security. By now the large majority of nations have implemented some form of corporate governance regime. The US government has tried to counter fraud and investor scepticism by...
